## Page 1

### Materials

¼ yard	Allover Dogs - Red (A)	8012-88
¼ yard	Eclipse - White (B)	3955-White
⅔ yard	Fusion Illusion - Indigo (C)	4368-Indigo
¼ yard	Dog Faces in Circles - Blue (D)	8013-77
1 ⅓ yards	Paw Prints - Ivory (E)	8010-44
¼ yard	Eclipse - Jet (F)	3955-Black
⅔ yard	Fusion Illusion - Cherry (G)	4368-Cherry
⅓ yard	Dog Accessories - Black (H)	8009-99
⅞ yard	Paw Prints - Black (I)	8010-99*
⅓ yard	Dog Silhouettes - Black (J)	8011-99
⅞ yard	Dog Faces in Circles - Red (K)	8013-88
3 ¼ yards	Allover Dogs - Blue (Backing)	8012-77

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Allover Dogs - Red (A), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (6) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Eclipse - White (B), cut:

- (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 1" x 7 ½" strips and (12) 1" x 6 ½" strips.

#### From the Fusion Illusion - Indigo (C), cut:

- (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 2" x 7 ½" strips.
- (1) 10 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 2" x 10 ½" strips.

#### From the Dog Faces in Circles - Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (6) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Paw Prints - Ivory (E), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 1 ½" x 6 ½" and (12) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (28) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (10) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (4) 4 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x 32 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (112) 1 ½" squares.
- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 51 ½" strips and (2) 1 ½" x 42 ½" strips.

#### From the Eclipse - Jet (F), cut:

- (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 1" x 7 ½" strips and (12) 1" x 6 ½" strips.

#### From the Fusion Illusion - Cherry (G), cut:

- (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 2" x 7 ½" strips.
- (1) 10 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 2" x 10 ½" strips.

#### From the Dog Accessories - Black (H), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (10) 3 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

#### From the Paw Prints - Black (I), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (10) 3 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Dog Silhouettes - Black (J), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 3 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

#### From the Dog Faces in Circles - Red (K), cut:

- Cut (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 4 ½" x 53 ½" strips.
- Cut (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 4 ½" x 50 ½" strips.

#### From the Allover Dogs - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 58" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 69" back.

## Page 2

### Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 1" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1" x 7 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) A-block (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the A-block. Sew (1) 2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-block to make (1) Block One (Fig. 2).

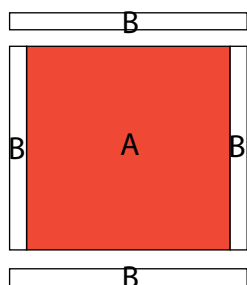

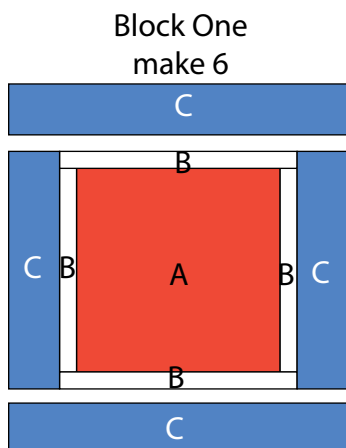

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (6) Block Ones total.

4. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) D-block (Fig. 3).

5. Sew (1) 1" x 6 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the D-block. Sew (1) 1" x 7 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the D-block to make (1) DEF-block (Fig. 4).

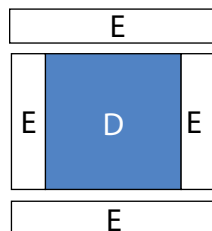

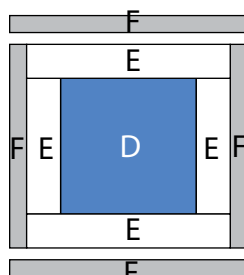

6. Sew (1) 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the DEF-block. Sew (1) 2" x 10 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the DEF-block to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 5).

7. Repeat Steps 4-6 to make (6) Block Twos total.

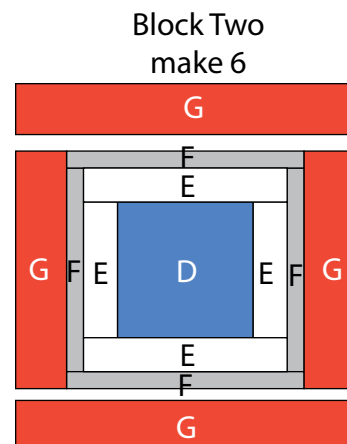

8. Place (1) 1 1/2" Fabric E square on the top left corner of (1) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

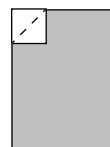

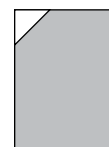

9. Follow Figure 8 for the seam direction to add a 1 1/2" Fabric E square to each of the remaining corners of the Fabric H strip to make (1) HE-block (Fig. 9).

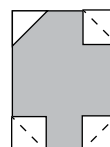

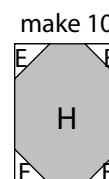

10. Repeat Steps 8-9 to make (10) HE-blocks total.

11. Repeat Steps 8-9 using (10) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric I strips and (40) 1 1/2" Fabric E squares to make (10) IE-blocks (Fig. 10).

12. Repeat Steps 8-9 using (8) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric J strips and (32) 1 1/2" Fabric E squares to make (8) JE-blocks (Fig. 11).

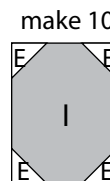

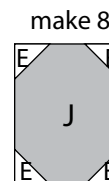

13. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip lengthwise to make (1) EHE strip (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (5) EHE strips total.

14. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip lengthwise to make (1) EIE strip (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (5) EIE strips total.

15. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip lengthwise to make (1) EJE strip (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (4) EJE strips total.

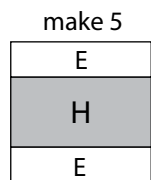

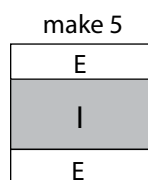

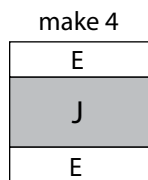

16. Sew (1) HE-block to each end of (1) EHE strip to make (1) H-bone (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (5) H-bones total.

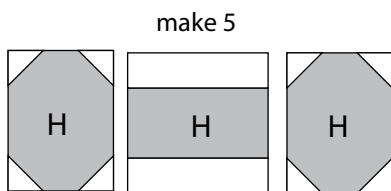

17. Sew (1) IE-block to each end of (1) EIE strip to make (1) I-bone (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (5) I-bones total.

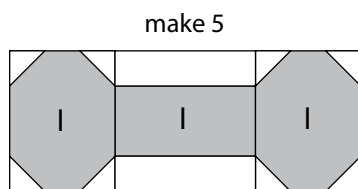

18. Sew (1) JE-block to each end of (1) EJE strip to make (1) J-bone (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (4) J-bones total.

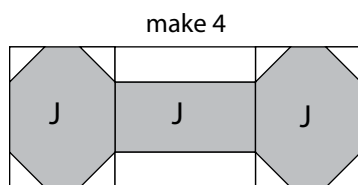

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)*

19. Sew (1) Block One to each side of (1) Block Two to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

20. Sew (1) Block Two to each side of (1) Block One to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.

21. Sew the (4) rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.

22. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $2$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

23. Sew (2) I-bones, (3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips, (1) H-bone and (1) J-bone to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the left side of the Center Block.

24. Sew (2) H-bones, (3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips, (1) I-bone and (1) J-bone to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the right side of the Center Block.

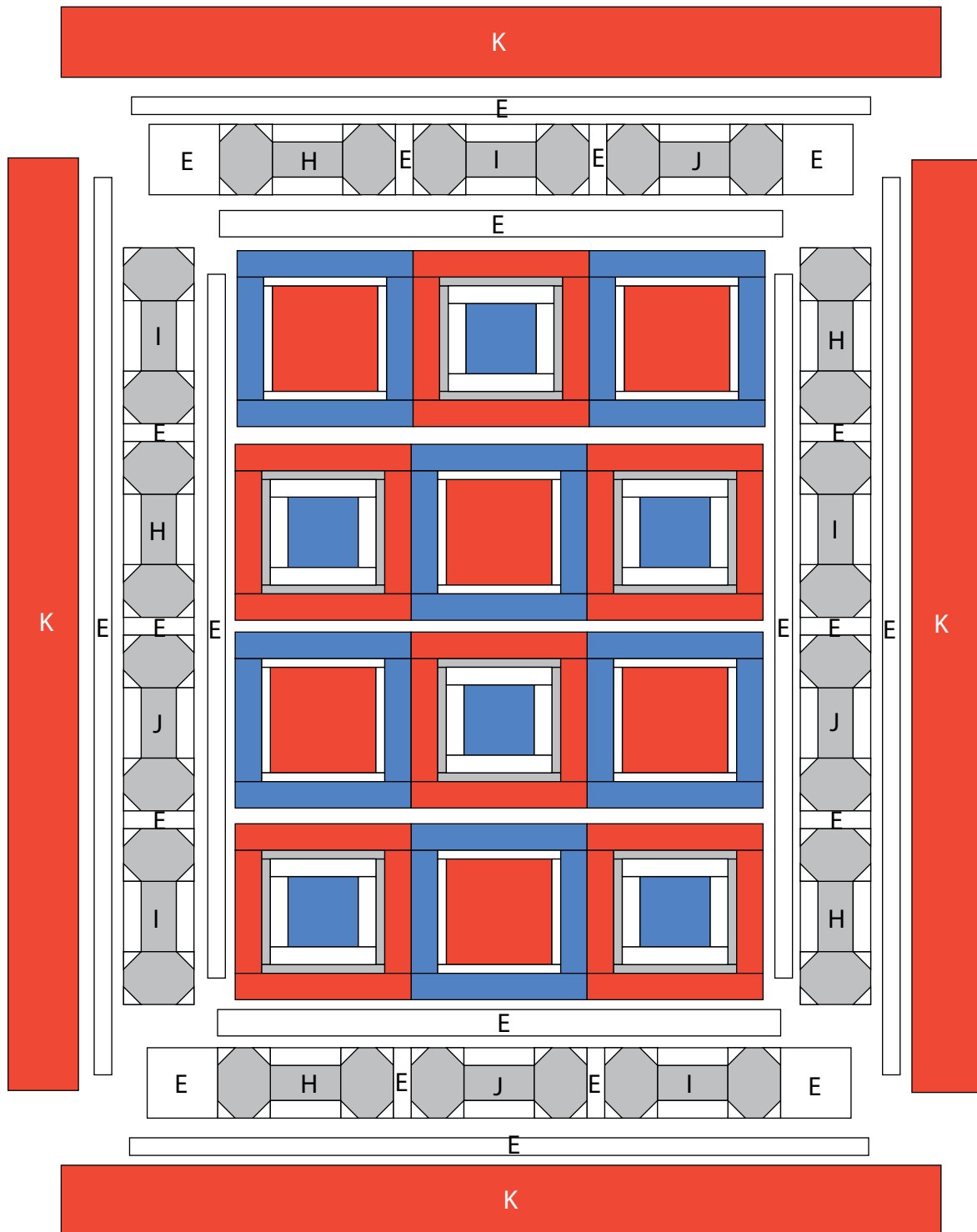
25. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $51\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

26. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $53\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $50\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

27. Layer and quilt as desired.

28. Sew the (6)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

29. Bind as desired.
